# The Dave Hardee Scholarship



For Vocal Performing Arts or Music Education

## **Guidelines**

### **Eligibility:**

- To be eligible for the scholarship an applicant must be a graduating high school student in the Cape Fear Tri-County area (New Hanover, Brunswick and Pender counties) during the 2019-2020 school year.
- The applicant must continue their study of vocal performing arts or music education in a postsecondary institution.
- The applicant must be an active member of a vocal performing arts program (vocal arts choir, chorus, church choir, etc.) during the 2019-2020 school year.
- **PLEASE NOTE:** Students should know that they <u>do not need to major in music</u>, but they must plan to continue their study of voice, or participate in the choral activities of, a postsecondary academic institution.

#### **Application:**

- On a CD the applicant must provide two songs or movements of differing styles, each of which is at least two minutes in length and which showcases their range and ability.
- Application form and audition CD must be post-marked by **February 11, 2020**.
- Please note that each applicant must provide a **PERSONAL STATEMENT** to be completed on a separate sheet of paper, an official high school transcript, a current photograph, and an audition CD.

#### **Rules & Requirements:**

- If any applicant is a student of a participating judge, that judge will declare that relationship.
- The decision of the judges will be final.
- If necessary, live auditions will be conducted.
- Recipients are expected to apply the scholarship toward academic expenses.
- The recipient may be invited to perform as a guest soloist at the WCS Spring concert on May 17, 2020, at CFCC's Wilson Center. Concert time is 4:30pm.
