Eligibility:

- graduating high school student in the Cape Fear Tri-County area (New Hanover, Brunswick, Pender County) during the 2022-2023 school year
- continue to study vocal performing arts or music education or participation in choral activities at a postsecondary institution. Applicant, however, is **not** required to major in music
- active member of a vocal performing arts program (school, community, or church choir) during the 2022-2023 school year

Rules & Requirements:

- if applicant is a student of a scholarship committee judge, that judge will inform the committee
- live auditions may be requested by committee
- the decision of the judges will be final
- recipient(s) expected to apply the scholarship toward academic expenses
- recipient(s) may be invited to perform as a guest soloist in the WCS Spring Concert to be presented on Sunday, May 21, 2023, at CFCC's Wilson Center. Concert 4:00pm.

Application Package:

- Application Form, current photo, official high school transcript, Personal Statement, and DVD
- on a DVD, applicant must provide two songs of differing styles, each at least two minutes long which showcase range and ability
